The Pine Rivers Showgrounds are a privately owned Showgrounds run by the Pine Rivers A. H. & I. Association. We are dedicated to putting on the Annual Pine Rivers Show and serving the local community.

Caravan Rules:

- Check in is between 12:00 midday and 4.30pm
 - Check out is before 11.00am
 - If you wish to check in early or check out late a \$20.00 fee is applicable to cover the costs associated with this. There is also a \$10.00 late check in fee
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- A refundable \$50 key deposit is payable upon arrival
 - Rent payment is due on or before the due date
 - Maximum length of stay is 28 days, with a no return period of 21 days.
 - Soft floor Camper trailers have a max stay of 7 nights
 - Caravaners are not permitted to undertake repairs, maintenance, or modifications on their caravans while staying at the showgrounds.
 - No Van or Car washing permitted
 - No Tents allowed.
 - No Tarps or Mats allowed on the ground. A small door mat is permitted on your site.
 - Two vehicles are allowed to be parked within your allocated site, providing they fit.
 - Power leads must be tagged. Before plugging in your power lead wrap it around the bar under the power box, and then feed lead through the hole and plug in
 - Noise is to be kept to a minimum. No amplified music after 10pm is allowed on your site.
 - Sullage hoses must be moved daily. Any waste other than water is to be collected.
 - Do not empty toilet waste in the amenities. Please use the Dump Points highlighted on the map.
 - Management reserves the right to remove a van if necessary (e.g. if the maximum stay is exhausted, eviction, overdue rent).

The Pine Rivers Show is the longest-running show in the Moreton Bay Region, with its origins dating back to 1891 when it was first known as the Moreton Show North Pine. Since 1915, it has called the Pine Rivers Showgrounds home — land donated by the Francis family — and has been a proud community tradition ever since.

Run entirely by locals, the Pine Rivers Show relies on the hard work and dedication of volunteers to plan, prepare, and maintain the grounds throughout the year. What's on in the local area?

Lawnton Aquatic Centre

Old Petrie Town Sunday Markets

Petrie Mill Waterpark and play space

Brisbane City

Hop on a train and take a ride into the heart of Brisbane city where you can visit some iconic museums, the Roma st parklands, Southbank man-made beach or hop on a city cat and take a ride along the Brisbane River. Trains to Brisbane from Lawnton take 40mins.



Showgrounds Rules:

- Children must be accompanied and supervised by an adult whilst on the grounds/using the amenities
- 5kph Speed Limit is enforced on the grounds
- Visitors, Children and Pets are not allowed near the Greyhound training track at the far end of the grounds.
- Please be aware CCTV is in use around the grounds.
- The showgrounds are a Multi-use facility, this will sometimes cause extra noise or changes to road use. Do not approach event personnel and please direct questions to the office.

Pets

Pets must be kept on a leash or confined at all times. Pet droppings must be picked up immediately and placed in a skip bin
Pets are not allowed in the amenity blocks.

Grey Water

Please ensure grey water is not impeding on any sites. Please limit the amount of grey water where possible. No Kitchen waste or lint is to be left on the grounds.

Camp Kitchen

The Camp Kitchen is a multi-use facility for our guests to enjoy. Please keep noise to a minimum after 10pm. Please always keep the BBQ and camp kitchen area clean and tidy.

Facilities

Guests have access to 3 main amenities blocks. All guests must be respectful of other patrons and keep the showers and toilets clean and tidy. Pets are not allowed in the showers.

Rubbish

Consider the environment where possible and reduce, reuse and recycle. We have General Waste, Recycling and Bottle recycling bins situated around the grounds for you to use. Please do not leave large bulky items in or near the bins.
